

What about your privacy?

The survey will be filled out anonymously. Your name and contact information will be kept separate from the survey.

In short: we do know that you participated in our survey, but nobody will be able to find out which answers you gave. Besides, if there are questions that you would rather not answer, just leave them blank. The data collected will be made available for other researchers at the end of the project. However, this is fully anonymized data. It will not contain any information that could be traced back to you.



Withdrawal study

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

Have you ever travelled abroad?

Maybe you have been on holidays or visited family members who live in another country. Or maybe you have lived abroad for a while yourself, also attending school there.



We are curious to know whether you have ever travelled abroad for a longer period of time, and if so, what kind of travels you have made. We would also like to know about your experiences at home and at school.

In short: we need your help!

What are we going to do?

We would like to ask you some questions.

We will do this by means of a questionnaire, which will be handed out and filled in by you in class.

We will ask you various questions, for example about your stays abroad, your health, happiness and feelings, how you are doing in school, how you like school and about your friends and family.

Why is it important to know these things?

If we know more about the trips that young people make and what this means to them, then we will be able to learn something new.

In this manner, we can find out whether schools should adapt their rules and regulations. It can also help teachers to understand how best to support you both before and after a trip, especially when this means you will miss school for some time.



Who participates?

Our survey will be filled out by high school students in The Netherlands, Germany, and Belgium.

This makes for a total of approximately 15,000 students, between the ages of 15 and 19 years.

Contact information

Apart from the survey, we will ask you whether you can give us your contact information such as your phone number and e-mail address.

You do not have to do so, but if you do, we may contact you again in a couple of years to see if you would like to participate in our study again.

You do not have to decide on this now; if you do not feel like participating in the future, you are always free to say so.

It is important to know that we will always deal with your information very carefully; we will not make it public or share it.
